**Week of July 6-10, 2020**     **Novel: The One and Only Ivan (Grade 3-5)**  
*The One and Only Ivan* is a children's novel by Katherine Applegate, first published in 2012. Winner of the John Newbery Medal in 2013, the highest honor for US children's literature, the novel received starred reviews in *Kirkus* and the *School Library Journal* and was a *New York Times* bestseller. *The One and Only Ivan* is based on the true story of a gorilla named Ivan, who was captured from the Democratic Republic of Congo and spent 27 years living in a cage in a mall before he was moved to Zoo Atlanta in 1994. In her novel, Applegate transforms Ivan into a fictional gorilla who can understand and speak human language, and who tells his story through a series of short, poetic vignettes.

**Week of July 20-24, 2020**     **Novel: Flora and Ulysses (Grade 3-5)**  
*Flora & Ulysses*, a novel by Kate DiCamillo, would simply be the poignant story of a lonely and cynical 10-year old named Flora if it weren't so funny. After all, how sad can it be when one of the main characters is a squirrel who becomes a poet after the life-changing experience of being sucked up by a giant vacuum cleaner and rescued by Flora who names him "Ulysses." The more serious story of how Flora learns to cope with her parents' divorce and her relationship with her mother, makes a friend, and begins to exchange hope for cynicism is brilliantly woven into the adventures of Flora and Ulysses. Winner of the John Newbery Medal in 2014, the highest honor for US children's literature.

# Apostrophe Kids Inc. Policies and Procedures

## Registration

1. A registration is deemed complete and students are enrolled with Apostrophe Kids Summer Camp once the registration form and all registration fees per student are submitted and approved by administration. Places will not be held in camp until registration is complete.
2. Although every effort will be made to accommodate students, Apostrophe Kids reserves the right to cancel the camp due to insufficient enrollment.
3. **Cancellation:** All fees (less \$50 administration fee) are fully refunded by May 31, 2020. A 50% refund will be issued from June 1-29, 2020. No refunds will be issued after June 30, 2020.
4. All cheques returned to the office as "Non-Sufficient Funds" will carry a \$25.00 service charge paid to Apostrophe Kids Inc. If cheques have not been replaced the student will not be allowed to attend the camp.

## Student/Parent Responsibilities

1. Camp hours are from 9 am - 4 pm. Any student who is picked up after 4 pm will be subject to a late pick-up fee of \$25. Late fee must be paid before the child returns to the camp the following day.
2. It is the parents' responsibility to accompany their child to and from the camp. Parents will accept full responsibility for their child until his/her camp begins and when it ends.

## Lunch and Snacks

1. Students are required to bring their own litterless lunch, snacks and refillable water bottles.
2. Afternoon activities may take place outside. Please have students dress appropriately.
